

HOW TO ORDER I-ROD® BY THE FOOT

WHAT SIZE I-ROD IS REQUIRED?

Larger diameter **I-Rod** supports greater weights. Refer to the **sizing chart** below to ensure adequate support for your load requirements.

WHAT'S THE OPERATING TEMPERATURE?

Determine your pipe's maximum operating temperature. Use standard **I-Rod** up to 181°F (83°C); **I-Rod HT** up to 340°F (171°C) and **PEEK** for temperatures up to 480°F (249°C). The maximum operating temperature for polyshrink on Nu-Bolts is 230°F.



WHAT LENGTH?

Strips of I-Rod are available in lengths of five feet, ten feet or one meter (3.28').



CALCULATING I-ROD LOAD VALUES

The table shows conservative estimates of the **total weight** of a foot of pipe filled with water. Multiply this number by your **support spacing** to get total weight loading, then select the number of I-Rods you'll need. Use 1" I-Rod if pipe diameter is 8" or less; 1 ¹/₂" I-Rod is for piping 10" or greater in diameter. Don't mix **rod sizes.** Use up to **three rods** to support desired weight.
